- Description:** This two-day training course is designed to provide simple and effective tactics and planning for Corrections Officers to remove and secure uncooperative, violent, or potentially violent inmates from a cell, reducing potential of injuries to staff or inmates. This 12-hour course focuses on verbal de-escalation strategies, team control tactics and scenario-based role play exercises.
- Training Objectives:** Upon course completion, the attendee will be able to:
- Understand the stages and goals of Cell Extraction.
 - Demonstrate situational planning and establishing team roles.
 - Demonstrate verbal de-escalation prior to cell entry.
 - Demonstrate appropriate tactical use of tools during cell entry.
 - Demonstrate safe cell entry, subject control, and handcuffing.
